How to Get Your Immigration Verification

To get your Immigration Verification go to The Work Number Main Menu page.

1. Click the "Immigration Verification" link.

You will now see an instructional page for getting your verification.

2. Select "Continue."

Note

You will only need to continue this process if you are verifying employment for immigration purposes.

You have successfully accessed your Immigration Verification. You have two options on this page.

3. You can print your verification to keep for your files or present to a verifier.
4. You can return to the main menu by clicking the "Back" link.

This verification is only valid for use by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS).

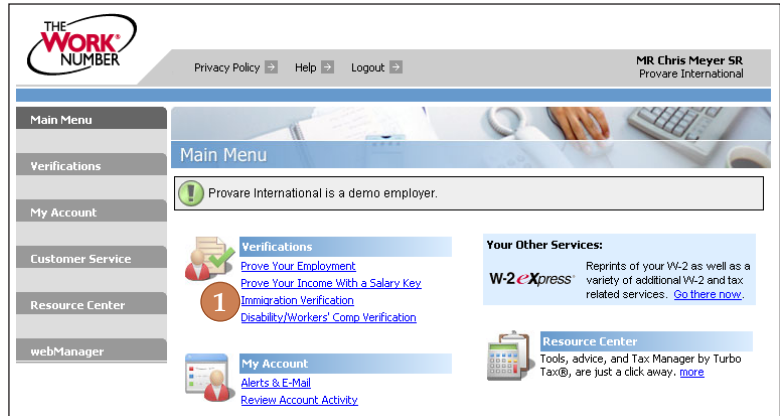
