SUBJECT: Compete with Canada Film Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 3626, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3626. The provisions of the Compete with Canada Film Act shall be terminated effective July 1, **2014** , and no claim shall be paid thereafter.
